COPE TO HOLD PIVOTAL CONGRESS NATIONAL COMMITTEE MEETING

The Congress of the People (COPE) will convene its Congress National Committee (CNC) meeting on March 29–30, 2025, in Bloemfontein, marking a critical step in revitalising the party under the theme "Restore the Dream, Build Prosperity for All."
