Media Statement:

COPE WARNED AGAINST THE JACOB ZUMA WRECKING BALL AND IS VINDICATED BY HIS EXPULSION FROM THE CORRUPT ANC.

The expulsion of Jacob Zuma from the corrupt ANC vindicates the correctness of the ethically and politically moral position of those who voluntarily resigned to form the Congress of the People (COPE).
